This book presents the fundamental design principles and approaches in geotechnical engineering. including an introduction to engineering geology, subsurface explorations, shallow and deep foundations, slope stability analyses and remediation, filters and drains, Earth retaining structures, geosynthetics, and bask seismic evaluations of slope stability, lateral earth pressures, and liquefaction.

This book applies the principles of soil mechanics, earthquake and focuses on the design methodologies in geotechnical engineering.
