The CCDF subsidizes child care for low-income families whose parents work or attend education or training programs. States are responsible for determining program priorities and overseeing funds. Providers bill the state for caring for approved children. "Nations Are Built of Babies" documents a national campaign by Ontario physicians to reduce infant and maternal mortality in the early twentieth century.
