Diese interdisziplinäre Studie beschäftigt sich mit drei großen Regisseuren des europäischen Autorenkinos - mit Ingmar Bergman sowie zwei gegenwärtigen Sternen am europäischen Kino-Himmel, André Téchiné und Julio Medem. Dass Zeit und Erzählen untrennbar miteinander verschränkt sind, gehört zu den immer wieder beschworenen Topoi der Erzähltheorie: Ohne Zeit gibt es kein Erzählen und ohne Erzählen keine Zeit. Die erzählte Geschichte vollzieht sich in der Zeit; der Akt des Erzählens hat einen Zeitpunkt, an dem er stattfindet; und der Erzählakt sowie der Rezeptionsprozess nehmen Zeit in Anspruch. Die Verschränkung von Zeit und Erzählen ist dabei nicht allein auf dieses systemische Bedingungsverhältnis beschränkt, auf das sich die Erzähltheorie konzentriert. Sie bringt darüber hinaus ein breites Spektrum ästhetischer Phänomene hervor: Zeit kann für den Roman kompositorische Relevanz besitzen, sie kann als Aspekt der Wahrnehmung thematisiert sein oder auch in ihrem Zusammenspiel mit Figurenkonzeptionen bedeutsam werden. Die eine Zeit - so die These, die die Beiträge des Sammelbandes verbindet - gibt es nicht. Nimmt man die Vielfalt der temporalen Phänomene in den Blick, so wird man schnell den Singular zugunsten des Plurals aufgeben müssen. Der Band beleuchtet aus methodischer, medialer, generischer und historischer Perspektive die Pluralität von Zeitformen. Erzählt wird nicht die Zeit - es werden Zeiten erzählt.

Message from Forever - Marlo Morgan 1998-06-03

Following her modern classic and worldwide bestseller *Mutant Message Down Under*, Marlo Morgan's long-awaited new novel is a tale of self-enlightenment about aboriginal twins separated at birth and the search for roots that reunites them from opposite sides of the globe. Once more Morgan unveils the inspiring aboriginal worldview while pointedly exposing the plight of an ancient race rapidly becoming extinct as a result of more than two hundred years of systematic discrimination. *Message from Forever* follows the lives of Australian aboriginal twins

who were taken from their young mother by Christian missionaries. The baby boy is sent to a huge sheep ranch, where he grows up with little adult supervision and random affection. On his own, Geoff develops his talent as an artist, producing work at a level well beyond his five years. The boy is adopted by an American minister and is raised in New England with little sense of who he is or of his cultural heritage. His sister is given only the first name Beatrice by the nuns at an Australian orphanage, where she encounters continual racism and experiences shattering losses for the first eighteen years of her life. Upon reaching adulthood, Beatrice leaves the orphanage to work at a boardinghouse. Beatrice hungers to know more about her ancestral roots. She walks away from her life in the city to strike out into the northern desert nation, where she goes on a walkabout with a small band of Aborigines. Geoff does not fare so well in America. As a teen, he runs away from home and slips into a life of crime, alcohol, and alienation. His addictions destroy him, and he finds himself on Death Row with little sense of how he got there. After decades of learning about people in the Outback, Beatrice leaves her nomadic life to become a "runner between both worlds." She returns to the Mutant world as a political activist fighting for aboriginal rights of citizens arrested and convicted of crimes in foreign countries, as well as a champion of the rights of adults who were taken from their native culture as children. Her life's work bring her into contact with her lost brother, though neither is aware of their relationship. Beatrice gives Geoff the "message from forever," which outlines aboriginal philosophy and principles of good living, along with an offer to return to Australia. As we read the message with Geoff, we are challenged to stretch our concepts of identity, spirituality, and openness transcends injustice and degradation, directing us to live our lives in accordance with ageless values and simple wisdom.

Julio Medem - Robert Stone 2013-07-19

This thorough account of the life and films of the Spanish-Basque filmmaker Julio Medem is the first book in English on the internationally renowned writer-director of *Vacas*, *La ardilla roja* (Red Squirrel), *Tierra*, *Los amantes del Círculo Polar* (Lovers of the Arctic Circle), *Lucía y el sexo* (Sex and Lucía), *La pelota vasca: la piel contra la piedra* (Basque Ball) and *Caótica Ana* (Chaotic Ana). Initial chapters explore Medem's childhood, adolescence and education and examine his earliest short films and critical writings against a background of a dramatically changing Spain. Later chapters provide accounts of the genesis, production and release of Medem's challenging and sensual films, which feed into complex but lucid analyses of their meanings, both political and personal, in which Stone draws on traditions and innovations in Basque art, Spanish cinema and European philosophy to create a complete and provocative portrait of Medem and his work.
