This edition presents, for the first time ever, the complete text and music of a nineteenth-century Parisian revue de fin d'année, providing a glimpse into an aspect of the theatrical and musical life of Paris that has generally been overlooked by scholars. Ohé! les p'tits agneaux!, the revue put on by the Théâtre des Variétés for the year 1857, was a gigantic theatrical spectacle in three acts and ten tableaux, with ninety-one separate roles played by twenty-three men and eighteen women, including extras, chorus, and dancers. Its music was assembled from popular tunes and musical theater pieces of the time, and its libretto (by playwrights Théodore Cogniard and Clairville) provides bitingly humorous commentary on contemporary events and theatrical productions.

Absente des objets traditionnels de la sociologie de l'art, ne relevant pas de la sociologie du sport, la danse constitue un point aveugle des sciences sociales. Dans l'aridité de ce Sahel statistique, bibliographique

et conceptuel, la place des danses de couple est marginale. Elles représentent pourtant une pratique culturelle fortement ancrée, largement partagée, aux multiples dimensions agissantes : mixité sexuelle, négociation des identités de genre, rituels du bal, processus de transmission, codification, fonctions sociales... Comme lieu de pratique stéréotypé, le bal, selon le sens commun, a connu au XXème siècle un âge d'or, un déclin et un renouveau, scandés d'un régime dont l'analyse montre la relativité. Laissés pour moribond au début des années 1970, danses de couple et bals connaissent depuis de multiples formes de résurgence et de permanence qui empruntent les voies de la folklorisation. La culture du bal est l'objet d'une reconstruction intense dans une pluralité de territoires, tandis que les notions de bal et de danse de couple sont instrumentalisées autant par les pouvoirs publics que par le tissu associatif pour composer de nouvelles sociabilités. A la transmission familiale s'est substitué le développement d'écoles de danse, puis, de cours dispensés par des structures polyvalentes (centres culturels) et associatives, aujourd'hui majoritaires, qui entretiennent un rapport antagoniste à l'improvisation. *States of Decadence* is a two volume anthology that focuses on the literary and cultural phenomenon of decadence. Particular attention is given to literature from the end of the 1800s, the fin de siècle; however, the essays presented here are not restricted to this historical period, but draw lines both back in time and forward to our day to illuminate the contradictory multiplicity inherent in decadence. Furthermore, the essays go beyond literary studies, drawing on a number of the tropes and themes of decadence manifested in the arts and culture, such as in music, opera, film, history, and even jewelry design.

Following the American Revolution, French observers often viewed the United States as a laboratory for the forging of new practices of liberté and égalité, in affinity with and divergence from France's own Revolutionary ideals and experiences. The volume examines French views through musical/theatrical portrayals of the American Revolution and Republic, soundscapes of the Statue of Liberty, and homages to the glorified figures of Washington, Franklin and Lafayette. Essays investigate paradoxical depictions of slavery in the United States and French Caribbean colonies of 'Amérique'. French critiques of American music and musicians, including the reception of Americanized or Creolized adaptations of European art traditions as well as American popular music and dance, are also presented. The subject of race

features prominently in French interpretations of American music and identity. These interpretations see French constructions of the Indigenous American and African American "exotic" that intersect with tropes of noble, pastoral savagery, menacing barbarism, and the "civilizing" potency of French culture. The French reinterpretation of African American music and dance reveals both a revulsion of Black alterity and an attraction to the expressive freedom, and even subversiveness, of these "foreign" forms of music and dance. Contributions include essays by music, dance, theatre and opera scholars, and the volume will be essential reading for students and scholars of these disciplines.
