**E. Franklin Frazier and Black Bourgeoisie -**  
James E. Teele 2002-05-02

When E. Franklin Frazier was elected the first  
black president of the American Sociological  
Association in 1948, he was established as the  
leading American scholar on the black family  
and was also recognized as a leading theorist on  
the dynamics of social change and race

relations. By 1948 his lengthy list of publications included over fifty articles and four major books, including the acclaimed *Negro Family in the United States*. Frazier was known for his thorough scholarship and his mastery of skills in both history and sociology. With the publication of *Bourgeoisie Noire* in 1955 (translated in 1957 as *Black Bourgeoisie*), Frazier apparently set out on a different track, one in which he employed his skills in a critical analysis of the black middle class. The book met with mixed reviews and harsh criticism from the black middle and professional class. Yet Frazier stood solidly by his argument that the black middle class was marked by conspicuous consumption, wish fulfillment, and a world of make-believe. While Frazier published four additional books after 1948, *Black Bourgeoisie* remained by far his most controversial. Given his status in American sociology, there has been surprisingly little study of Frazier's work. In E. Franklin Frazier and *Black Bourgeoisie*, a group of distinguished

scholars remedies that lack, focusing on his often-scorned *Black Bourgeoisie*. This in-depth look at Frazier's controversial publication is relevant to the growing concerns about racism, problems in our cities, the limitations of affirmative action, and the promise of self-help.

*Law, Rights and Ideology in Russia* - Bill Bowring 2013-04-17

*Law, Rights and Ideology in Russia: Landmarks in the destiny of a great power* brings into sharp focus several key episodes in Russia's vividly ideological engagement with law and rights. Drawing on 30 years of experience of consultancy and teaching in many regions of Russia and on library research in Russian-language texts, Bill Bowring provides unique insights into people, events and ideas. The book starts with the surprising role of the Scottish Enlightenment in the origins of law as an academic discipline in Russia in the eighteenth century. The Great Reforms of Tsar Aleksandr II, abolishing serfdom in 1861 and introducing jury trial in 1864, are then examined and debated as genuine reforms or the response to a revolutionary situation. A new interpretation of the life and work of the Soviet legal theorist

Yevgeniy Pashukanis leads to an analysis of the conflicted attitude of the USSR to international law and human rights, especially the right of peoples to self-determination. The complex history of autonomy in Tsarist and Soviet Russia is considered, alongside the collapse of the USSR in 1991. An examination of Russia's plunge into the European human rights system under Yeltsin is followed by the history of the death penalty in Russia. Finally, the secrets of the ideology of 'sovereignty' in the Putin era and their impact on law and rights are revealed. Throughout, the constant theme is the centuries long hegemonic struggle between Westernisers and Slavophiles, against the backdrop of the Messianism that proclaimed Russia to be the Third Rome, was revived in the mission of Soviet Russia to change the world and which has echoes in contemporary Eurasianism and the ideology of sovereignty.
