Mañana en la batalla piensa en mí - Javier Marías 1994

Como sucede en las últimas novelas de Javier Marías, la primera frase ya dice mucho, quizá demasiado: "Nadie piensa nunca que pueda ir a encontrarse con una muerta entre los brazos y que ya no verá más su rostro cuyo nombre recuerda". Esto es lo que le ocurre al narrador de su nueva y extraordinaria novela. Víctor Francés es guionista de televisión y "negro" o "escritor fantasma", encargado de redactar los discursos de los hombres importantes e ignorantes. Divorciado recientemente, es invitado a cenar a su casa por Marta Téllez, mujer casada cuyo marido está de viaje en Londres y madre de un niño de casi dos años. Tras la cena galante, el hombre y la mujer pasan al dormitorio, donde, "aún medio vestidos y medio desvestidos", Marta Téllez empieza a sentirse mal hasta que agoniza y muere en una escena sobrecogedora. Esa infidelidad no consumada se convierte así en una especie de "encantamiento", con problemas bien reales e inmediatos: qué hacer con el cadáver, avisar o no avisar, qué hacer respecto al marido, qué hacer con el niño dormido, qué diferencia hay entre la vida y la muerte. Víctor Francés tomará pronto sus decisiones, o más bien no las tomará y se irá dejando llevar por sus pasos, inofensivos unas veces y otras envenenados. Conocerá a la familia de su muerta, al padre, Téllez, viejo académico y cortesano; al marido, Deán, con su capacidad de comprensión y de inclemencia infinitas; a la hermana menor, Luisa, a quien seguirá sin propósito. Y se irá poniendo en situación de contar sus secretos a quienes no debe. En un Madrid invernal y nocturno, dominado por la niebla o por las tormentas como una isla sitiada, el narrador se convertirá en una sombra que no quiere ni busca nada y, sin embargo, va encontrando: al Único, para quien deberá escribir un discurso, en una hilarante escena palaciega; a su amigo Ruibérriz de Torres, aficionado al hipódromo y que lleva pintada en la cara su esencia de sinvergüenza; a la puta Victoria de otra larga noche de su pasado en la que confundió su rostro con otro hombre. Y entretanto una maldición va resonando: "Mañana en la batalla piensa en mí, y caiga tu espalda sin filo: desespera y muere".

Madrid, 1931-1934 - Santos Juliá 1984

A los trabajos que sobre la 11 República española ha publicado Santos Juliá se añade ahora este libro que obtuvo el premio "Ortega y Gasset" Villa de Madrid (1982). En él se intenta reconstruir minuciosamente el proceso y los determinantes que convirtieron la fiesta popular con que Madrid celebró la instauración de la República en el abierto enfrentamiento de clases que caracterizó la vida madrileña durante el invierno de 1933-34. A la par, y por el hecho de reconstruir este proceso en un espacio reducido -una ciudad- aunque sumamente significativo -Madrid-, el autor propone un modelo de interpretación de las luchas de clases urbanas durante la 11 República que, más allá de sus determinantes políticos, tenga en cuenta el propio desarrollo de la ciudad, las transformaciones de su estructura, los procesos migratorios, la crisis que afectó a sus principales industrias, el tipo de sus organizaciones obreras y patronales y, en fin, la dinámica de los discursos y las prácticas de clase. De acuerdo con esos presupuestos metodológicos, el libro concede una atención especial a la fiesta como momento fundante de la República para desembocar, tras el análisis de la cristalización de conciencias enfrentadas de clase, en el estudio de las diferentes formas de lucha de los dos sindicatos obreros y las distintas agrupaciones patronales. El "pueblo todo entero" que aparece como sujeto del primer capítulo del libro se convertirá, durante este corto y denso proceso, en el "frente obrero" y el "bloque patronal" que aparecen radicalmente enfrentados en su última parte. Santos Juliá es profesor del Departamento de Ciencias Políticas y Sociología de la UNED. Ha publicado, en diversas revistas y obras colectivas, una veintena de artículos sobre temas relacionados con la II República y es autor de *La izquierda del, PSOE, 1935-36* y de *Orígenes del Frente Popular en España*, aparecidos en esta misma editorial.

*Transnational Neofascism in France and Italy* - Andrea Mammone 2015-09-23

This book describes the establishment, evolution, and international links of the extreme right in one of the main Western European areas. Andrea Mammone details the long journey in the development of right-wing extremism in France and Italy, emphasizing the transfer, exchange, and borrowing of ideals, personnel, and strategies and the similarities among neofascist movements, activists, and thinkers across national boundaries from 1945 to the present day - including the Cold War years, the election of the European Parliament in 1979, and the 2014 EU elections.

Mammone analyzes the adaptation of neofascism in society and politics; the building of international associations and pan-national networks; and the right-leaning responses to the defeat of fascism, European integration, decolonization, the events of 1968, immigration, and the recent EU-led austerity politics. As a book implicitly on space, borders, and belonging, it shows how some nationalisms may embody a transnational dimension and, at times, even pan-European stances.
