First published in 1934, it is here available for the first time in an authorized English translation. A realistic tale in the best tradition of the novels of social protest of Zola, Dostoevsky, José Eustasio Rivera, and the Mexican novels of the Revolution, The Villagers (*Huasipungo*) shocked and horrified its readers, and brought its author mingled censure and acclaim, when it was first published in 1934.
